

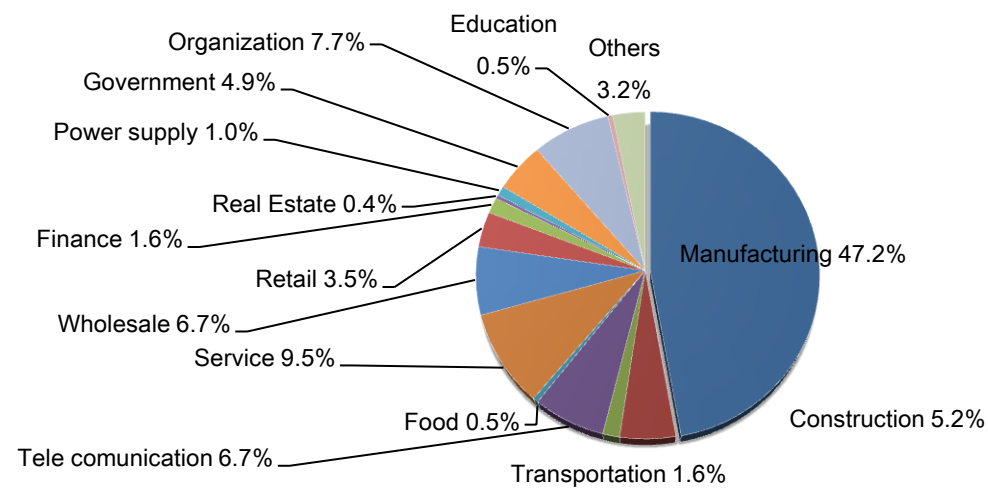


EXHIBITION HIGHLIGHTS

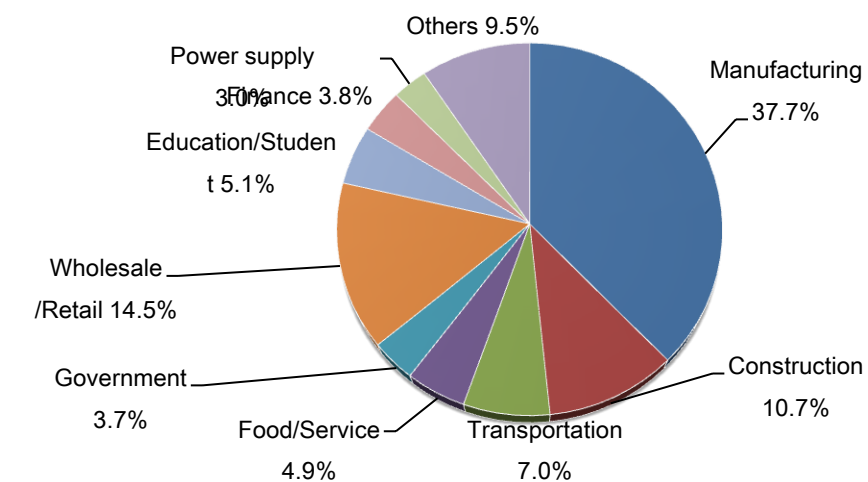

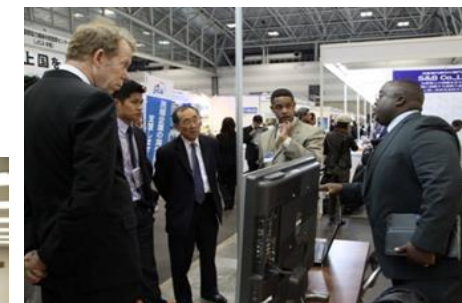

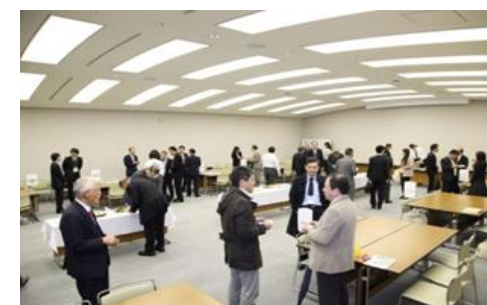
